Study Guide - Reference Verses

Hearing and not seeing

Romans 10:17 So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. Matthew 11:15 He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Merciful/Compassionate

<u>Psalm 103:13</u> As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.

Gracious

<u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u> For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Longsuffering/Slow to Anger/Patient

<u>2 Peter 3:9</u> The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

Abounding in Goodness

<u>Jeremiah 29:11</u> For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Abounding in Truth

<u>John 1:14</u> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Forgiving

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Just

<u>Deuteronomy 32:4</u> He is the Rock, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.

Identifying Characteristics of God

<u>Deuteronomy 4:31</u> "For the LORD your God is a compassionate God; He will not fail you nor destroy you nor forget the covenant with your fathers which He swore to them.

<u>2 Chronicles 30:9</u> "For if you return to the LORD, your brothers and your sons will find compassion before those who led them captive and will return to this land. For the LORD your God is gracious and compassionate, and will not turn His face away from you if you return to Him."

<u>Nehemiah 9:17</u> "They refused to listen, And did not remember Your wondrous deeds which You had performed among them; So they became stubborn and appointed a leader to return to their slavery in Egypt. But You are a God of forgiveness, Gracious and compassionate, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness; And You did not forsake them.

Nehemiah 9:31 "Nevertheless, in Your great compassion You did not make an end of them or forsake them, For You are a gracious and compassionate God. Psalm 78:38 But He, being compassionate, forgave their iniquity and did not destroy them; And often He restrained His anger And did not arouse all His wrath.

<u>Psalm 86:15</u> But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, Slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

<u>Psalm 103:8</u> The LORD is compassionate and gracious, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness.

<u>Joel 2:13</u> And rend your heart and not your garments." Now return to the LORD your God, For He is gracious and compassionate, Slow to anger, abounding in lovingkindness And relenting of evil.
